### City of Cody Council Proceedings Tuesday, December 20, 2022

A regular meeting of the Cody City Council was held in the Council Chambers at City Hall in Cody, Wyoming on Tuesday, December 20, 2022 at 7:00 p.m.

Present: Council Members, Heidi Rasmussen, Diane Ballard, Justin Baily, and Emily Swett; and City Attorney Scott Kolpitcke; City Administrator Barry Cook, and Deputy Clerk Barb Curless.

Absent: Mayor Matt Hall, Council Members Jerry Fritz and Andy Quick.

Council President Ballard called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Council Member Rasmussen made a motion seconded by Council Member Swett to approve the Consent Calendar as presented including approval of Minutes: Regular Minutes from December 6, 2022, approve Vouchers and payroll in the amount of \$1,469,095.32 and award Bid 2022-17 to Modern Machinery for (1) LeeBoy 3000C Force Feed Loader in the amount of \$338,000.00. Vote was unanimous.

Council Member Swett made a motion seconded by Council Member Rasmussen to reject all bids for bid 2022-16 for one (1) Ford F600 chassis with armored body in the amended amount of \$263,000.00 and to allow staff to make changes in the bid packet and rebid 2022-16. Vote was unanimous.





WHEREAS, the banking services provided by the Bank include serving as a depository for the public funds of the Contract Holder; and


